New exhibit for Leo Schimanszky

Local artist Leo Schimanszky has a new exhibition this month, at the Galerie Bernard Desroches in Montreal.

His New Projects exhibition will have 20-25 pieces - sculptures and paintings - as well as photographs showing the progress of the artist's work. One of the works featured is a 21st century head, which Schimanszky has been working on for the past two years, and a painting titled "Tea-time". Both works are striking in their colours. Always an optimist, an enthu-

siastic Schimanszky said he is trying to make people smile and feel happy by using brilliant colours. "People are too stressed now," he said.

The colours have meaning, he pointed out: red for love, white for peace green for the fountain of youth and yellow for friendship. His message is one for the whole world, he says.
